

It's been a long process to do it all, only to find that there are many uncertain elements ahead - none that we could've foreseen, and the requirements keep changing. We feel it's essential to be able to choose our own (Christian) teachers and the money now required to pay the government each year is steep with possible unknown "fees" down the road.

SO WHAT NOW? We feel God has led us thus far and nothing will be wasted. The blocks will be used for additional needed buildings on the HOH grounds. We'll strive to continue to 'make the main thing the main thing' in investing in the lives of our orphans. This group of children has become a family, with wonderful house "moms" and with Phillip and Azalea at the helm. Thank you for continued prayer for this precious "family".

COMING UP - I'll be leading a team of 8 or 9 to Africa at the end of March and the beginning of April. Pray that all of the things we are bringing for Zim arrives and that we have grace at the borders getting through without a "hitch".
