Hi Everyone!

I hope you and your families are all doing well. We are a little over halfway done with the month of June and let me tell you what... It has been quite a month for the Coules clan! My parents and I arrived back in France on June 6. As some of you may know, this past week my mom was having some health complications and had to be hospitalized for several days. The doctors said that she is doing better; however, they are still not exactly sure what was causing her condition. Nevertheless, we are grateful that she is able to be home and that she is safe and healthy.

As the time for me to move to Palestine draws closer and closer (I only have about 6-7 weeks left), I am beginning to prepare for the move as well as preparing for my own classroom. I have spoken with the Principal of the Bethlehem Evangelical Academy to get a more specific idea of what subjects and content I will be expected to cover as well as logistics of what the school provides. Since the large majority of the students are English language learners, the main goal in kindergarten (for reading and writing) is for them to be able to hear and replicate sounds well, such as consonants, vowels, blends, and digraphs. I have to say, I am getting SO excited for this coming fall! I cannot wait to meet my new kiddos, their families, and the staff that I will be working with.

Please be in prayer for the students that I will have this fall. My prayer is that the classroom will be an encouraging and uplifting environment filled with the love of Jesus. I pray that my students will be able to learn not only the academic content, but also about the great love that Jesus has for them. I would also appreciate it if you could be praying for our staff.
