Introduction - Sin is a major obstacle in our relationship with God. Isaiah continues to address this problem and shows us the way back to fellowship with God.

I. Admitt Our Sin..

- A. Sin goes deeper than our outward actions. It originates in our hearts and minds. (Is. 59:3-13)
 - 1. Things we think about.
 - 2. Things we desire.
 - 3. Things we tell ourselves.
 - 4. These form tracks and pathways in our life.
- B. There is an abrupt change as we move from verse 8 to verse 9.
- C. Not being willing to admit our sin makes things worse spiritually.

II. Broken by Our Sin.

- A. Admission leads to brokenness. A state of lament.

B. What brokenness looks and feels like:

- 1. (v.9) Psychologically
- 2. (v.10) Physically
- 3. (v.11) Emotionally

III. Confession of Our Sin.

- A. While it’s sometimes hard to separate these aspects, at some point there is not just an admission and brokenness over our sin, but confession of our sin to God.

 - 2. Sins
 - 3. Iniquities
