 - B. How paradise was lost.
 - C. The consequences of our choices.
- III. Paradise Regained. (Is. 66:5-24)
 - A. The false worship of Cain.
 - B. The miraculous birth.

- C. The hand of the LORD.
- D. Three voices from the LORD: A voice from the city. A voice from the temple. A voice of the LORD who renders recompense.
 - A voice of uproar from the city: Messiah will judge and make things right.
 - 2. A voice from the temple. Messiah will reign and reverse the consequences of the fall.
 - 3. God will create a new heaven and earth.
 - 4. A voice of recompense from the LORD. There will be a final judgment where the eternal destiny of all mankind will be decided.
- E. The three places God chooses to dwell:
 - 1. In heaven.
 - 2. With people who are humble, broken in spirit and tremble at His Word.
 - 3. In the midst of His people on earth, when He returns to reign.
