***Introduction - All the Gospels report on the unusual nature of Jesus’ baptism by John. What we see is a rare glimpse of the Godhead.***

***I. The Doctrine of the Trinity.***

- A. One God.
- B. Three Persons.
- C. Jesus, the Father, the Holy Spirit.
- D. The doctrine of the Trinity is difficult but absolutely, biblically true. And the implications of it impact ultimate reality.
  - 1. If God is only One, or does not exist:
  - 2. If God is Triune in nature . . . .
- E. We were created in the image of God from the mold of the Trinity.

***II. The Baptism of Jesus.***

- A. We see all three persons of the Trinity involved at Jesus’ Baptism.
  - 1. Jesus.
  - 2. The Holy Spirit.
  - 3. God the Father.
- B. Ultimate reality is a community of persons knowing and loving each other.
  - 1. Hear the Father –
  - 2. Hear Jesus –
  - 3. See the Holy Spirit –
- C. The Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are glorifying each other.

***III. Digging Deeper.***

- A. We are invited to share in God’s loving community.
- B. We enter His loving community when we believe in Jesus and glorify God.
- C. What it means to “glorify” God.
