Each	of the Go	spel writ	ers begins	his work b	v tracing	back the	activity	of Jesus t	o its	origin:
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- Matthew to the human lineage of Jesus.
- Mark--baptism of Jesus, with the descent of the Spirit & the voice of the Father from heaven.
- Luke to the birth of Jesus from a virgin.

From the very outset of John's Gospel, he wants to make crystal clear--When we are meeting Jesus of Nazareth, we are encountering not only a man, but the very God of the universe.

One of the *distinguishing features* of John's Gospel is that he includes a series of *"I am"* statements by Jesus, all of which also *clearly* point to His *deity*:

"I am the______ of Life." (6: 35)
"I am the _____ of the world." (8: 12)
"I am the _____ for the sheep." (10: 7 ff)
"I am the _____ Shepherd" (10: 11, 14)
"I am the _____ and the Life" (11:25)
"I am the _____ and the _____."
"I am the _____ the ____ and the _____."

Another *distinguishing* feature: "Amen, Amen" ("Verily, Verily", "Truly, Truly" "Very Truly", "I assure you") used *only* in John's Gospel. **24 times**—(1: 51; 3: 3, 5, 11; 5: 24, 25; 6: 26, 32, 47, 53; 8: 34, 51, 58; 10: 1, 7; 12: 24; 13: 16, 20, 21, 38; 14: 12; 16: 20, 23; 21: 18) (Matthew, Mark use a *single* "Amen"; Luke uses "Truly")

About **90**% of the material in John's Gospel is ______, not included in the Matthew, Mark or Luke. The material he chose to include clearly shows *his purpose of ______(20: 31)*

- the encounter with the woman at the well
- His dialogue with *Nicodemus*
- series of miracles climaxing with the *raising of Lazarus from the dead*.
