o John is referring to <b>Jesus' baptism</b> which had occurred earlier.
• How much earlier? (at least days earlier!)
<ul> <li>John is making a point of the coming to abide with Jest because this is one of the signs prophesied about Messiah. It confirms Jesus' identity</li> </ul>
Isaiah 11: 1-2
• Isaiah 42: 1
• Isaiah 61: 1, quoted by Jesus Himself—about Himself.
• v. 33 "He who sent me to baptize with water (This was directive) told me,
'The One you see the <b>Spirit</b> descending and <b>resting on—</b> He is the One who
with the Holy Spirit."
o The only use of "baptism of the Holy Spirit" in John's Gospel.
o <b>Acts 11: 15-17</b> (Peter-Gentiles) I remembered the word of the Lord, "John baptized
with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit."
o 1 Corinthians 12: 12-14 "We were all by one Spirit into one body

• Galatians 3: 2 "Did you receive the Spirit by works of the law or by hearing
with?  Romans 8: 9 "If anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not
belong to Him."

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<ul> <li>Here is a <i>question</i> that revolves around <i>how much</i> did John really <i>understand</i> about Jesus' mission?</li> </ul>
o In light of <b>Luke 7: 18-19</b> "Are you the one who is to come, <b>or should we look fo</b>
?"(Matthew 11: 3).
■ He knew the <i>Kingdom of God</i> was near. (Matthew 3: 2)
He knew the <u>Kingdom of God</u> was near. (Matthew 3. 2)  He knew the Messiah was <u>on the scene.</u> (Luke 1: 69-70, 76; 3: 16)
<ul> <li>He saw Jesus receiving the <i>Spirit</i>. (Luke 3: 22, Matthew 3: 16)</li> </ul>
• He knew Jesus was the "Son of God" (Voice from the Father-Luke 3: 22 and
Matthew 3: 17) (John 1: 34)
<ul> <li>He knew Messiah would "take away the sin of the world." (John 1: 29)</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>He knew repentance was involved: John was preaching a baptism of</li> </ul>
repentance for the forgiveness of sins." (Luke 3: 3 and Mark 1: 4)
• <b>Mathew 3: 10, 12</b> He knew <b>judgment</b> was involved in Messiah's coming.
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"Even now the ax is ready to strike the root of the trees. Therefore, every tree that doesn't produce good fruit will be **cut down** and thrown into the **fire**!" "His winnowing shovel is in His hand, and He will clear His threshing floor and gather His wheat into the barn. But the **chaff** He will **burn up with fire** that never goes out!" (3:11) He will baptize you with the **Holy Spirit**
