***I. A Crushing Problem.***

- A. A man with leprosy came to Jesus.
- B. Leprosy was a terrible incurable disease.
- C. Leprosy was associated with God’s judgment, especially for the sin of pride.
  - 1. Miriam (Numbers 12)
  - 2. Uzziah (II Chronicles 26)
- D. There were specific instructions in the Mosaic Law about what a leper should do, and how they should live. (Leviticus 13-14)
- E. The leper in Mark 1 scandalously risked everything to come to Jesus for help.
- F. How the leper approaches Jesus says a lot about him.
