Introduction —In the garden of Gethsemane Judas betrays Jesus with an armed contingent expecting armed resistance. Judas got it wrong.

I. Swords and Clubs.

- A. In the Bible the sword means something more than just killing.
- B. The sword represents the authority and power of this world's Kingdoms to compel people.
- C. In coming to arrest Jesus with swords and clubs, they don't understand Jesus at all.
- D. The authority of the Kingdoms of this world are always associated with the sword.
- E. Jesus is inaugurating a new kingdom, the Kingdom of God that orders things differently.
