 - 1. He didn't need anything.
 - 2. Something was wrong.
- D. A Biblical idiom for prayer is "drawing near to God."

II. Our Access to God in Prayer.

- A. When Jonah began to pray, he looked toward God's holy temple.
- B. God's holy temple is a picture of the Gospel.
- C. God's holy temple gives us the good news and bad news of the Gospel.

- D. The bad news is related to the temple's connection to God's moral law.
 - 1. In the holy of holies was the ark of the covenant.
 - 2. The ten commandments were in the ark of the covenant.
 - 3. God will only meet with us over His law.
- E. The temple also shows us the good news of the Gospel.
 - 1. Over the ark of the covenant was the mercy seat, in Greek a word meaning "propitiation."
 - 2. The sacrificial blood that was shed for the sins of the people was placed on the mercy seat.
 - 3. Jesus is the mercy seat.
