God's Mission.

- A. First, we see that God is on mission to limit the extent of evil in the world.
- B. God is concerned about people and wants to rescue them from the consequences of sin in their lives.
- C. God involves Jonah (and us) in His mission.
- D. God is a sending God.

- A. God commissions Jonah to go speak to the people of Nineveh.
 - 1. Jonah refuses the first time, so God sends him again.
 - 2. But God will not stop sending!
- B. God's mission is not just for the wellrested and talented, but for anyone who says I believe in God and belong to God.
- C. Many times, God sends the least likely and least worthy people on special missions.
