Introduction —After Jonah's preaching and spiritual revival in Nineveh, Jonah collapses in anger toward God. Jonah doesn't understand why God let the Ninevites off.

I. Misunderstanding God's Love.

A. Jonah's response to God indicates that he doesn't understand how God's love works.

B. Jonah has fallen back into his old sins, and that is behind his anger toward God.

C. But, Jonah's life is dependent on God's patient love.

II. Receiving God's Patient Love.

- A. Believers can fall back into old patterns of sin and self-deception. But God is patient.
- B. We don't realize how persistent our sin is, and we mask it instead of admitting it by rationalizing, minimizing and excusing it.

- C. How can we avoid falling back into our old sins?
 - 1. Examine your heart. Look at your motives.
 - 2. Identify and smash the idols in your life.
 - 3. Make sure we are consistent in using the spiritual resources that God has made available to us.
 - a. Prayer.
 - b. Receiving God's Word.
 - c. Worship and fellowship.
 - d. Confession and repentance.
