Introduction – The apostle John tells us of how a woman's life was completely changed when she heard the Gospel. Today we'll look at what we can learn from her testimony.

I. What is a Testimony?

- A. Many of the townspeople believed in Jesus because of the woman's testimony.
- B. A testimony is a first-hand authentication of some fact important for other people.

II. What Did She Testify To?

A. She witnessed to what Jesus did for her personally. (Subjective truth)

"Come and see a man who told me everything I ever did."

B. And she witnessed to the truth about who Jesus is. (Objective truth)

He is the Messiah.

C. Jesus didn't follow the conventions of that day. He broke through them and showed her grace.

D. Because of the grace Jesus showed toward her, she was very close to understanding the objective truth of the Gospel.

III. How Did She Testify to the Truth of Jesus?

A. She testified with urgency.

B. She testified with humility.

C. She testified with simplicity.

D. She testified with bravery.

E. How was the woman able to talk with her friends and the townspeople in this way?
