

"Snapshots of a New Creation"- Part 2 Acts 4:18-31 ◆ Pastor Jim Lennon August 25, 2024

Introduction – After those who believed in Jesus were filled with the Holy Spirit, their lives were radically changed. Four things stand out in their lives as a new creation in Christ. First, in spite of suffering, they served God consistently. Today we consider a second mark of a believer's response to suffering.

I. Praying to God Personally.

- A. When Peter and John are released from prison, they joined other believers in prayer to God.
- B. They didn't just pray prayers, they prayed to God as an aspect of their personal relationship with Him.
- C. A relationship with God is only personal if it is two-way.
- D. God has spoken to us and revealed Himself to us in His Word.

- E. In their prayer, Peter and John focus on the character of God.

II. Praying to God Biblically.
