

## "The Conversion of Cornelius" Part 2

Acts 10:34-48 ◆ Pastor Jim Lennon March 23, 2025

Introduction – The story of Cornelius' conversion reveals two main things that follow every conversion to Christ.

## I. An Internal Spiritual Realization.

- A. Conversion happens when we believe in Jesus and receive the Holy Spirit.
- B. Jesus said that it is the Holy Spirit who gives us new spiritual birth (John 3:3-8).

- C. The apostle Paul echoes that truth in (Titus 3:3-7)
- D. Note when the Holy Spirit "fell upon them" (Acts 10:44)
- E. We see the same pattern in (Ephesians 1:13-14).

## II. External Physical Manifestations.

- A. Those who are truly converted by the Holy Spirit will manifest two responses.
- B. <u>First</u>, each believer is given a spiritual gift(s) from the Holy Spirit to minister to others and glorify God.
  (I Corinthians 12:4-7) (I Peter 4:10)
- C. Cornelius and those with him were given the gift of speaking in tongues.
- D. What does that mean?
  - 1. Note the frequency in Acts.
  - 2. Miraculously, they spoke in other recognized languages.
  - 3. This was a recapitulation of Pentecost for the Gentiles.
- E. <u>Second</u>, the Holy Spirit is manifested in our worship.
  - 1. Everyone worships something.
  - 2. The Holy Spirit dramatically changes what you worship and why.
- F. The apostle Paul mentions other manifestations of the Holy Spirit seen in the lives of people converted to Christ, like the fruit of the Spirit. (Galatians 5:22-23)
