Introduction – The early church kept expanding northward to Antioch, where some Greeks believed the Gospel and along with others planted a church there. The church in Antioch is a great example of what God designed the church to be, and how He designed it to grow.

## I. The Ministry of Barnabas.

- A. When Barnabas arrived in Antioch he had three responses.
  - 1. He witnessed the grace of God.
  - 2. He rejoiced.
  - 3. He encouraged those who believed.
- B. The name "Barnabas" means "son of encouragement."
- C. Barnabas had a ministry of encouragement/exhortation, from the Greek word "parakaleo."
- D. Parakaleo is speaking the truth with love.

## II. Why the Parakaleo Ministry is Important.

- A. It is found between the ministries of evangelism and discipleship.
- B. Barnabas is encouraging believers to grow in the Lord and exhorting them to be faithful to the Lord.
- C. Look at how important his ministry was "considerable numbers were brought to the Lord." (11:24)
- D. To grow spiritually, we need to be surrounded by people who are giving us truth wrapped in love.
- E. The Parakaleo ministry is hard.
- F. The Parakaleo ministry happens face to face in regular conversations.

## III. How Do We Do This Ministry?

- A. Luke tells us why Barnabas was good at this ministry.
- B. Baranbas was a recipient of Jesus' promise of the "Paraclete."
