Introduction – *After His resurrection from the dead, Jesus told His disciples that His coming was anticipated in the Law of Moses, the prophets and the Psalms. Today we will look for Him in the Law of Moses.*

I. Jesus is the Christ.

- A. The word “Christ” from the Greek word “Christos” means “anointed one.”
- B. “The anointed one” in Hebrew is the word “Meshiach,” from which we get the word “Messiah.”
- C. Many people were anointed with oil in the Bible. What set the Messiah apart was being anointed by the Holy Spirit.

II. Jesus in the Law of Moses.

- A. Jesus confirmed that we should look for Him there.
- B. He is the promised “seed” of the woman.

- C. He is the promised “seed” of Abraham.
(Genesis 22:17-18)
