Introduction – *We are in a sermon series on faith in the book of Habakkuk. Last time we learned that we need to wait on the Lord in evil times. Today, we learn that while we wait, we need to spread the message of God’s coming judgment and the salvation that He sends.*

I. Waiting For Answers.

- A. Habakkuk is waiting in a watch tower. (1)
- B. Habakkuk was probably in the tower acting as a sentry on military duty.
- C. Habakkuk is waiting for God to answer him.
- D. God answers Habakkuk one more time.

II. God’s Three Concerns.

- A. While God doesn’t give Habakkuk the answers he wants to hear, God answers him by giving him specific instructions.
- B. God is concerned for His people, so He sends them His Word, the message that will save them from His judgment.

- C. God’s first concern is that people HEAR His Word. (2)
 - 1. So, he sends Habakkuk to warn the people of His judgment so they can be saved.
 - 2. God wanted people to hear the message accurately.
 - 3. In addition to Habakkuk, God sent the prophet Jeremiah to warn the people of His coming judgment unless they repent.
- D. God’s second concern is that people RESPOND to His message so they can be saved and not perish. (2)
- E. God’s third concern is that His people have HOPE in what is coming.

(Habakkuk 2:3)

"For the vision is yet for the appointed time; It hastens toward the goal and it will not fail. Though it tarries, wait for it; For it will certainly come, it will not delay.

- F. The ambiguity is clarified in the book of Hebrews 10.
